

Donation Policy

Cross Roads Parish Council

1. Introduction:

Cross Roads Parish Council sets aside a percentage of the precept each year to make donations to local community organisations/volunteers based in the village.

2. Terms and Conditions for Grant Applications:

Donations will be considered and approved at Parish Council meetings.

Donations must benefit the community of Cross Roads Parish Council

3. General criteria to be applied to all applications:

Cross Roads Parish Council recognises the importance of supporting local groups, organisations, and volunteers who contribute to the wellbeing of our parish. To ensure fairness, transparency, and accountability, the following guidelines apply to all donations made by the Council.

4. Financial Donations to Community Groups:

- Cross Roads Parish Council can make financial donations to community groups that hold an official community group bank account.
- The amount of any donation is at the discretion of the Parish Council.
- No group may receive more than one financial donation in a single calendar year.

5. Support for Individuals Contributing to the Community:

- Cross Roads Parish Council may support individual's parishioners who provide voluntary services to the community (for example, a volunteer who regularly collects litter)
- Support for individuals will take the form of practical items (e.g., litter bags, litter pickers, gloves) rather than direct financial assistance.
- No individual may receive support more than once in a calendar year.
